Each year, in September, MHC hosts the Manitoba Equestrian Championships. MHC extend invitations, to horse clubs around MB, and invites each of them to host a competition within the MEC. The result is a huge multidiscipline weekend, ranging from Barrel Racing and Cutting to Eventing and Showjumping, and everything in between. If you've never been before, you must go to take in the atmosphere and watch disciplines that you'd never even thought about before. Mark it on your calendar for next year.

Teams are divided into East (usually of the Red River) and West. Teams compete against each other for all the disciplines, and at the end of the weekend, results are tallied up, with the victors earning a gold MHC medal.

MHT hosted an Event competition for the Entry and Pre-Training level.



Mornings were dressage tests and the afternoons were derby style in the Grand Prix ring, with a combination of showjumps and cross-country jumps. Helen Martin placed first in the Entry level and Miranda Turijen placed first in Pre-Training. Congratulations to Team West who reigned supreme over the Championships.
