

MANITOBA HORSE TRIALS (MHT) Membership Information 2017



Full MHT Membership Includes:

- Full voting privileges
- Insurance (competitors)
- Newsletter
- Eligibility for year-end awards
- Savings and preferred status for clinics and events

Temporary membership fees for any MHT activities/events are \$45. If you plan to attend two or more events, a full membership is more cost efficient. A temporary membership can only be purchased once per show season, however, it may be upgraded towards a full membership in the same show season.

Equestrian Canada (EC) Membership:

- **Eventing National Membership must be purchased with your EC Sport License.** Register early and get your Event Canada 2017 Omnibus (listing of competitions & EC Dressage Tests)
- Mailed to you prior to the start of the season.

Which Membership(s) do I need?

Derbies: Manitoba Horse Council (MHC) and MHT memberships required.

Horse Trials: MHC, MHT, EC and Eventing National memberships required.

Course user fee is required every time the cross country course is used

Volunteer Information

Memberships are not valid until a Volunteer Cheque is RECEIVED

Year end points will not count until the volunteer commitment is fulfilled

MHT is proud to be a volunteer run organization! Our success comes from the efforts of the members and their volunteer work. Each member is required to provide a volunteer cheque at the time of membership application or renewal. The cheque should be made out to "Manitoba Horse Trials" and **post-dated** for September 30, 2017.

- Individual members provide a \$100.00 volunteer cheque. It is destroyed after a **minimum** of 6 hours of volunteer time is completed.
- Family members provide a \$150.00 volunteer cheque. It is destroyed when a **minimum** of 10 hours of volunteer time is completed.

Members who have not completed their volunteer commitment by September 30th will have their volunteer cheques cashed.

You will be contacted by the MHT Volunteer Coordinator to volunteer your time for various MHT activities and shows. You may also contact any board member to indicate that you would like to volunteer for specific jobs/tasks. Opportunities will also be posted on our webpage and Facebook page.
