- 1) I would like to thank Kyla and Deb for running with the Education Clinic that will be held in February. Great job getting the location and arranging for the presenters.
- 2) I have reached out to Barry Tyerman to arrange for him to come to Winnipeg and design 4 – 5 courses for each level for us to use this year. I want to move the jumps around once this year, but the courses get more challenging as the season goes on.
- 3) I have asked Barry if he could build us some jumps or guide us for repairs of existing jumps.
- 4) Once I have a timeline for Barry, I will reach out to Greg Vaadeland from Saskatchewan to see if he is available to come out and work with Barry to work on his Level 1 courses design certification. Greg also builds cross country jumps, and he may be able to build some here which would save us shipping expenses.
- 5) Last year the Board vote to spend \$5,000.00 on jumps so I would like to use that money to buy supplies for Barry and Greg if they are able to come.
- 6) I have confirmed with Robby that she will be our scorer for our shows this year and she is willing to teach someone, so we have a backup. The person must have intermediate excel experience with knowledge of V-lookup, formulas, and to be able to transfer info from one sheet to another within the workbook. If you know of someone who might like to take this on, please let me know and I will contact them.
- 7) I have brought some different swag to look at for volunteers, prizes, and potential sale

- 8) I would like to put together three committees – one for special events, one for shows, and one for clinics. I will get Deb the information that I would like sent out to the members and they can reach out to me if they are interested in helping on one of them.
