Event Report February 2023

- 1) Education Clinic - We have a good number of people registered. We are thinking about airing the program over FB live. Do you think there is enough interest for this and if so we will have to promote it. Our 3 presenters are all on board and ready.
Opening remarks by Karla at 1:00, Elders at 1:15, Maura at 2:00 and Lesa at 2:30. We would like to have some door prizes, possibly hats and certificates for schooling rounds. Deb will check to see if Peppercorn has a screen or Karen will bring one. I will be purchasing a projector for the club's use.
- 2) Deb has put together an eblast for volunteers for the 3 different event committees. I would like to know the names that have already come forward to different members and which committee they would like to be a part of. I would like 4 people for fundraising, 4 for special events and 7 for planning the events.
- 3) Barry Tyerman is coming the last weekend of April so lets hope the weather cooperates. He will be coming for 4 – 5 days depending on if he goes out to Willville for a day. His cost is \$500 per day plus expense. I will let him use our truck so that he can move around the course. He will design 4 different courses for each level and we will have to move the jumps into place after he is done. Barry usually stays with Geri so I will contact her to see if he can again or I will approach Pat to see if he could stay there.
- 4) I will get in touch with Callum Reid to see if he can be available when Barry is here to find out if we can repair some of our older jumps to make them usable and what needs to be done.
- 5) I will get in touch with Greg from Saskatchewan about purchasing the jumps so that we will hopefully have them here for April. I will use up the \$5000.00 that was already passed on but we will also have to allow for freight.
- 6) I am thinking that between the jumps and the course building we will be close to the \$10,000.00 so fundraising and sponsorship will be very important this year to cover all the expenses.

- 7) I have not heard back from Danae about the warm-up jumps and reached out her to again on Wednesday Feb 1.
- 8) The cost of the toques is \$15.50 each. We gave some away to members that attended the AGM in November 2022. We have 30 left.
